

General directions and map for GSW meetings:

The Geological Society of Washington holds its meetings at the Cosmos Club, 2170 Florida Avenue, NW, at the intersection of 22nd Street, Florida Avenue, and Massachusetts Avenue. The main entrance to the Club is on Massachusetts Avenue, west of the Indian Embassy. The John Wesley Powell Auditorium is located toward the northwest side of the building. The preferred entrance is adjacent to the small, gated private parking lot on Florida Avenue.

From 95 south, take 495 west to the Connecticut Avenue south exit. Follow Connecticut Avenue to Florida Avenue. This is a right turn just before Connecticut divides, about four blocks south of Wyoming Avenue. Parking in the neighborhood is generally plentiful within a few blocks of the Club, but be careful to examine parking restriction signs.

The closest Metro stop to the Cosmos Club is Dupont Circle (red line). From the Q Street exit of the station, walk west on Q Street about 2.5 blocks then bear right on Massachusetts Avenue; the main entrance to the Club will be on your right. You will pass the Embassies of Morocco and India (both on the right). If you cross 18th Street, you are walking in the wrong direction.
